

## CODES OF DRESS

### SCHOOL UNIFORM:

It is a requirement that all children wear school uniform. The school uniform consists of the following:

- Navy blue fleeces with school logo
- Navy blue sweatshirt with school logo
- White shirt or blouse
- Grey knee length skirt
- Grey trousers
- Sensible black shoes/black trainers
- Blue gingham dresses for summer
- White polo shirt with Family group

Looking after school uniform is the responsibility of the parents and children and we urge that all items are clearly labelled. We are willing to label items at the time of purchase and will try to send out reminders for parents to check that lettering has not faded.

We also run a thrift shop where good quality items can be purchased.

If a child is not wearing a school uniform and has not got a note from his/her parent then:

- A warning is given
- On the second day the parent to be contacted by letter.

### PE Kit:

Junior children only are required to come to school in their PE kit on the days which they have PE. Children and parents will be notified of PE days each term.

Children must wear an appropriate school PE kit listed below:

- Normal school jumper/fleece
- White T-shirt
- Navy/black shorts
- Navy/black tracksuits or jogging bottoms may be worn in cold weather.
- When working in the hall all children will work in bare footed as recommended by LEA guidelines.
- Although plimsolls are acceptable for outdoor PE, sports footwear technology has developed to a point where affordable sports shoes now

offer better support for children and so we encourage parents to purchase these if possible.

- If kit forgotten or inappropriate kit worn, first a warning to be given, then parents contacted to be asked to explain and to offer kit from the thrift if needed.

### Clothing for Clubs

Children will need to bring an appropriate change of clothes for lunchtime and after school clubs.

### Jewellery:

- No jewellery to be worn (This to include anything worn on the neck or wrists)
- Only ear studs to be worn
- Only sensible watches to be worn

### Makeup and body art:

- No nail varnish, makeup or transfers to be worn
- The above to include children drawing on their hands

### SWEETS IN SCHOOL:

- Children should not bring sweets into school. This includes chocolate in lunchboxes.

### BAGS IN SCHOOL:

- We encourage you to purchase the various bags displayed in reception but if you decide not to we ask that the bags you purchase be of the same size because of issues with cloakroom space.

### MOBILE PHONES:

- Mobile phones must be kept in the reception area and can be collected after school.

### LOST PROPERTY:

Lost property will be recycled after 1 term if items are not claimed or if they are unnamed.
