

PLAYGROUND BEHAVIOUR

- We have invested in a large amount of playground equipment so ask that the children do not bring in their own toys.
- Adults will stop any games they feel are dangerous which include no tag catching and chasing games.
- Play fighting and wrestling are not allowed.
- If children are not playing appropriately they will be given a warning but if this continues they will be isolated and could possibly be excluded from the playground for a period of time.

Dealing with unacceptable playground behaviour:

- Each adult has a responsibility to ensure that all children are behaving appropriately.
- Children are expected to respond to requests/instructions given by any adult employed by the school.
- Each adult employed by the school has the authority to impose an immediate isolation on a child displaying inappropriate behaviour. This could be 'time-out' on the playground, child sent to the lunchtime 'time-out' area in the school or sent to a member of the behaviour team.
- Any further action is the responsibility of the behaviour team and should take place after discussion with the adult(s) dealing with the problem.
- Any problems experienced during playtimes must be noted in a day book and reported to the class teacher at the end of playtime.
