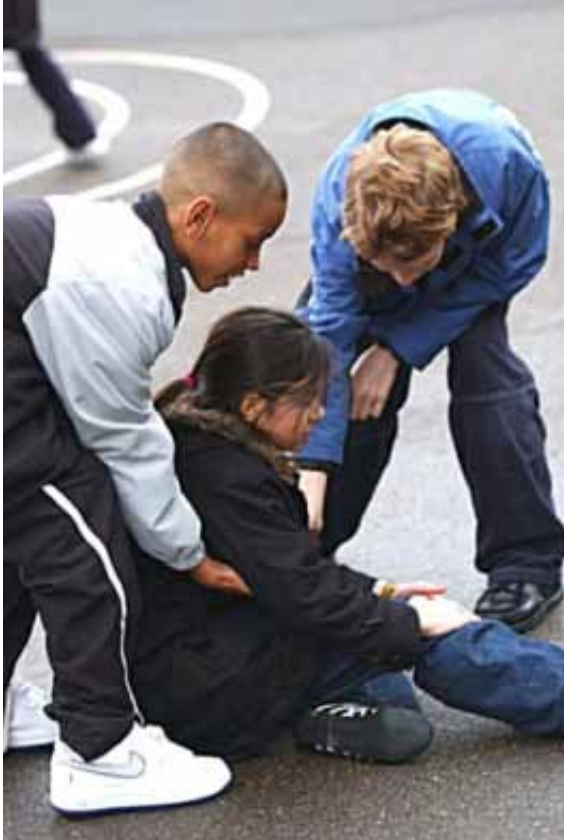
Family SEAL: New Beginnings

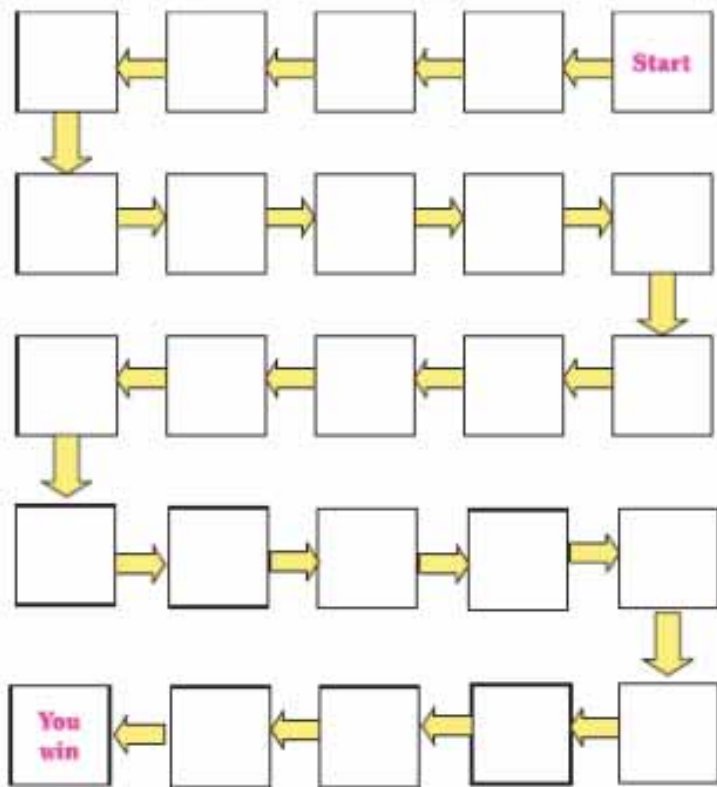
- Be positive;
